

SECOND CENTURY STEERING MEETING – MAY 28, 2008 MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Cunningham. Present were members Brantingham, Pinder, Henricks, and Clark.

Members reported on the following issues of note:

- ✚ Kiwanis raffle of electric car – any groups that want to participate in selling tickets can arrange to share part of any profit after the cars are paid for.
- ✚ Tompos and Brantingham attended a work session of the Town Council to present the list of community projects in the hopes of establishing some “formal” program of who should be responsible for annual maintenance/set-up, etc. They reported that the first presentation of this was well received by Council.
- ✚ Plans are in the works to establish a “Fall Arts Festival” in the park being led by Dan Bickle, the owner of the theater. This idea was well received by steering members.
- ✚ The dues letter was approved by a majority of the steering committee and sent out with final General Meeting dates of June 19th – Kiwanis, August 13th – Lions, and October 7th – Chamber. Our usual meeting reminder cards will be sent out for each advising SCC members how to make reservations for the host groups meal.

Cunningham led the discussion concerning how the information gathered at last fall’s community meetings would be presented at the three group meetings. It was agreed that while all projects identified under each category would be available for anyone to see only a list of the number one priority in each category would be handed out. This idea is to help focus beginning efforts on manageable projects within each segment of concern. Tompos agreed to prepare the lists for the upcoming meetings.

It was decided that it would be appropriate to first present the SCC steering committee’s plans at a work session of the Town Council so they will be the first to hear, and understand, what our plans are. Pinder agreed to notify us of one of two dates (June 9th or June 16th) that would be first up on the town’s agenda.

Cunningham, Tompos, and Clark will attend the Town Council work session to present.

It was felt another steering meeting would be necessary prior to the Kiwanis meeting on the 19th of June to plan that day’s presentation. Meeting was set for June 16th at 7:30 a.m., SCC.

(Note: 1) Town Council work session was held June 9th at 8:00 a.m. Members Cunningham, Tompos, and Clark attended and presented to Council. 2) Limited members attended the June 16th meeting so arrangements for presentation at Kiwanis were made between Cunningham, Clark, and Tompos.)
